Stonnington too rich for most first-home buyers

A RECENT study into housing affordability for first home buyers has listed Stonnington among the most expensive.

The Bankwest study estimated it would take the average couple almost 13 years to save a 20 per

cent deposit of \$297,300. Real Estate Institute of Victoria communications manager Robert Larocca said Stonnington was home to some of Melbourne's most expensive real estate.

'The inner-east of Melbourne has always been the sweet spot of property prices and not usually where most first home people moving into Stonnington buyers are going to make a start," Mr Larocca said.

The study said property prices had eased slightly, but this had had little effect on housing affordability.

Hawthorn Hocking Stuart director Glen Coutinho said most

were second-home buyers wanting their children to attend private schools.

HILARY Cook had always loved the heritage-listed house on Kooyong Rd, Armadale.

So when she discovered by chance it was for sale on the internet, she took it as an omen.

'It wasn't advertised in the paper and there was no 'For Sale' sign up," Ms Cook said. "And the inspection was the following day.

After purchase, Ms Cook and her husband Peter Geraerts commissioned an extensive renovation that would turn the house into a modern home fit for a family with two teenagers.

The renovation, by Elsternwick-based company EME Design, was honoured at the 2011 Building Designers Association of Victoria awards.

"We made it more light and airy and improved its environmental credentials," he said.

"It's far more sustainable to work with what's there rather than starting again.
